#### **Dear Parents or Guardians:**

It's that time of year again when we begin our enrollment for the 2024-2025school year. Remember that a 10-student limit is wonderful for student/teacher ratio, but it can also fill up quickly.

Remember to save each form before going on to the next one. If your signature is required, you may include a jpeg of your signature. When all of the forms are complete you have two options.

- 1. You may print out your forms at home, include your signature as needed, and return them to the school office with your \$75 registration fee. Your child will be registered that day.
- 2. You may attach the completed documents and email the forms to <u>director@calvarylcms.org</u>. I will print them at school, but your child's registration will not be complete until you send in the \$75 registration fee.

#### TUITION POLICY AND PARENTS' AGREEMENT OF SUPPORT

The undersigned parents agree to pay a total of \$ for the 2024-2025 school year in Nine (9) equal monthly payments beginning on or before the close of business on **September 1**st.

- Tuition payments are **due on or before close of business on the 1st calendar day of each month**. Tuition is paid on a **9-month schedule from September through May**, with payments beginning the month the school year starts and ending 1 month before the school year ends.
- Checks are to be made payable to **Calvary Early Learning Center** and dropped off in the school office or mailed directly to CELC; 4725 Old William Penn Highway, Murrysville, PA 15668.
- Checks returned for insufficient funds will be assessed a penalty of \$15, in addition to any fees imposed by the issuing bank.
- A \$10 late fee will be assessed for any payment received after close of business on the 5<sup>th</sup> calendar day of the month. Late fees will accumulate monthly at \$10 each month until payment is received.
- Children will not be able to attend class if a tuition payment is not made by the 10<sup>th</sup> calendar day of the month until the past due amount (including the \$10 penalty) has been paid.
- Parents receive a 3% discount on the cost of tuition if the total year's tuition is paid in full by the 15th calendar day of August.
- Staff members will receive a 20% discount on the cost of tuition for their child(ren) to attend school.
- Any child from a clergyman's family will receive a 20% discount on the cost of tuition.\*
- Families with more than one child attending the school will receive a 10% discount on the tuition cost for the second (third or fourth) child.\*
- \*Only one discount can be applied per child. (Either the clergy discount or the additional child; not both.)
- Parents are encouraged to make every effort to pay tuition on time. For circumstances requiring special consideration, parents can speak with the Administrator in confidence. The Administrator will make every reasonable effort to reach an agreement that is in the best interest of all concerned parties.

#### Choosing Between the Fours Class and PreK

Fours: Mornings 3 days/week; Monday-Wednesday-Friday; 9:00 - 11:30 a.m.

**PreKindergarten:** Afternoons 4 days/week; Monday-Tuesday-Wednesday-Thursday; 12:30 - 3:00 p.m.

The following helps to identify a child ready for the PreK class:

- At least 4.5 years of age on the first day of class.
- Strong verbal skills. (Easy to communicate with teachers.)
- Able to listen to a 5-10 minute story.
- No longer requires an afternoon nap.
- Independent bathroom skills.
- Attempts to write first name.
- Separates easily.
- Likes coming to school.
- Can recognize his/her name.
- Can follow 2-step directions.
- Able to handle 4 days/week schooling.
- Knows shapes and colors.
- Can correctly hold a pair of scissors.
- Can cut straight lines.
- Knows some letters and numbers 1-10.
- Previously has been in a school setting.

As you look over this list, carefully and prayerfully consider which option is best for your child. Know that whether your child attends the Fours or the PreK Class, he/she will be ready for kindergarten. Ultimately the choice is up to you and what is best for the family.

# Do you want to give your toddler an introduction to school? Check out CELC's Two's class. You will find:

- a loving and safe Christian environment. Bible lessons and songs are part of each class.
- opportunities for socialization; free play with other children. Learning to share and how to take turns are daily lessons.
- introduction to alphabet, numbers, colors, and shapes.
- art activities that are appropriate for small hands and fine motor-skills.
- classes that are held from 9:00-11:00 a.m. only Tuesdays, only Thursdays, or both. Your choice!
- no registration fee. Pay only for the classes your toddler attends.
- a teacher and aide per 10 students (class limit)
- a few hours to yourself.

#### What is CELC's Two's Class all about?

CELC wants each child to know that he/she is special and wonderfully created by God.

Our objectives for the Twos are to begin building the foundation for a lifelong love of learning through play and a variety of planned activities. We will also work to build social and emotional skills, including developing relationships with other children and adults.

The children begin learning to listen to others, to follow directions, and to express themselves appropriately. They are introduced to letters, numbers, shapes, art, and reading.

Parents choose whether their child will attend Tuesdays only, Thursdays only, or both Tuesdays and Thursdays. Because this class is pay-as-you-go, it is essential that parents sign up a week in advance, so our teacher knows how many students to prepare for. If parents do not sign up for the next week's class, they run the risk of the class being full.

Each class is \$20. Parents purchase vouchers in the church/school office as needed and gives one voucher to the classroom teacher when they drop off their child.

Parents purchase the vouchers and sign-up for the next week in the school office. If a child is not able to attend a particular day, there is no payment, but parents should call the office to let us know he/she is not coming. Another parent may want that spot for their child.

#### Dear CELC Families,

We have advertised Calvary Early Learning Center as *The best kept secret in Murrysville*. We don't want to keep it a secret any longer, and we need your help.

Registration opens to you, our current families next week during Lutheran Schools Week, so that
you have first chance at reserving a spot for your child's next class. You know that our \$75
Registration Fee is nonrefundable. However, if you register your child before Easter Sunday,
March 31, 2024, we will deduct the \$75 off of your August full-tuition payment or your
September tuition payment.

We have long believed that our best advertisement is word of mouth from those who know us best, and this year, we are going to reward you for sharing our secret.

- When a new family enrolls a child in either the Fours, PreK, or Kindergarten class because of your recommendation, we will **deduct 20%** off of your monthly tuition for each month the referred child attends CELC.
- If you tell **two** new families about CELC, and they both enroll a child in either the Fours, PreK, or Kindergarten class because of your recommendation, we will **deduct 40%** off of your monthly tuition for each month the referred child attends CELC, and so on.
- If your recommendations bring five new families to our 4s, PreK, or K classes, your tuition will be FREE!

#### How will this work?

There is a new question on the second page of our Application Form:

How did you hear about CELC?

The parent filling out the Enrollment Application needs to name you. Each time a new child is enrolled in one of the classes listed above and answers this question with your name, we will mark your account. As long as the child(ren) remain enrolled during the 2024-2025 school year, you will receive a monthly tuition deduction of 20% X the number of referrals.
